Girls are asked to wear clothes that can get dirty or painted on. **Closed-toed** shoes are required.

We ask that girls bring a reusable water bottle. Girls who bring a reusable water bottle every day will receive an award. Using a reusable water bottle is also part of a Mountain Momma patch.

*Wednesday night will be an overnight event for girls who wish to stay. Daisies and Brownies staying overnight must have an approved adult staying with them. Popcorn and a drink will be provided as an evening snack. Girls are welcome to bring their own snacks as well.

Mountain Mommas of Appalachia is a 12 Month Patch Program through Girl Scouts of Black Diamond Council. Every month has a theme as well as a Mountain Momma to learn about. Each day of Day Camp we will cover the lessons and activities for 4 months. The girls will be learning a great deal and staying very busy.

A \$15 scholarship is available for each girl attending the Mountain Momma Day Camp. Please submit the appropriate drawing or essay with your application and payment.

Daisies – submit a drawing of yourself doing one of your favorite Girl Scout activities or a picture of what you think a Mountain Momma looks like. Remember to write your name somewhere on your picture.

Brownies – submit a picture of what you think a Mountain Momma looks like and a one paragraph story about her. Remember to write your name on your work.

Juniors – submit a one page story about a Mountain Momma and an adventure you go on with her. What do you think a Mountain Momma is like? What things would she like to do? Pick a location in Appalachia to travel to.

Cadettes – submit a 1 page story about taking a trip through Appalachia with two women you know who grew up in West Virginia. Include three facts about Appalachia in your story.

Seniors – submit an essay about whether you take pride in being a woman from Appalachia. Are you proud to say you're from West Virginia? Why or why not? What are the advantages and disadvantages about being someone from Appalachia? 2 page minimum please.

Ambassadors – submit an essay about the outside world's perception of people from Appalachia and West Virginia specifically. Do you believe we should work to change that perception? If so, how can we do this? What are the positive aspects of Appalachian life you would teach others about? 2 page minimum.
