1) **The Mary Dean Brewer Gold Award Scholarship** – one, \$1,000 award, renewable annually for up to three years (up to \$4,000 total), for a Girl Scout who has earned the Girl Scout Gold Award.

2) **The Geraldynne Zimmerman Scholarship**— two, \$2,000 awards for Girl Scouts with at least four continuous years of Girl Scout experience who will attend South Carolina State University, Claflin University, or Orangeburg-Calhoun Technical College.

To apply, please submit the completed GSESC Scholarship Application Form for which scholarship you are applying (along with copy of acceptance letter from college, official high school transcript, and three references). If applying for the Geraldynne Zimmerman Scholarship SAT or ACT scores must also be submitted.

Please be aware there will be more applicants than available scholarships, so it is important to make a first-rate presentation and to include everything the committee should know when making the decision about who will be awarded the scholarships. In general, it is always a good idea to include enough detail to give clarity to the information supplied on applications. Be sure each question is thoroughly answered, with specific examples of Girl Scout experience, community service, extra-curricular activities, and future goals.

A complete application with all supporting materials must be received in the Florence Service Center, Attn: Danielle Sykes, 181 E. Evans St., Ste 400, Florence, SC 29506 by March 15, 2021 in order to be considered for any scholarship.
