GSCCC offers outdoor programming and camping at five sites:

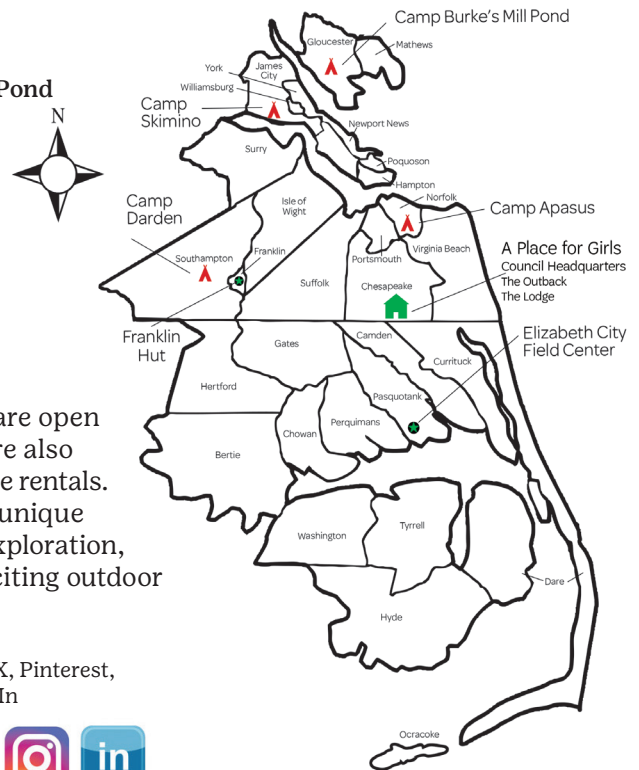
